Each applicant must provide the following information in good order. If any of the criteria below is not included with the application the candidate will automatically be disqualified.

- Three (3) letters of recommendation: one personal, one education related and one from the Chamber member.
- A letter of intent stating major, college attending and a brief summary describing yourself and your goals.
- A "resume" of extra-curricular/community activities
- An essay on the topic, "How I plan to use my college education to better myself, others and the community." One page, double spaced.

Winners of the scholarship will receive the amount awarded upon proof of successful completion of their first term of college.
